How you can help The Great Big Dorset Hedge Campaign...

- **Become a hedge surveyor:** *Walk and assess* 3 Km lengths of the 160 Km Jubilee Trail near you (or one of the other major trails that we are working on). Record your findings on the survey sheets we provide.
 - We give you free, online Training followed by on-site practice at a variety of sites across Dorset year.
 - Your records will be uploaded onto the GBDH map and give us a growing and detailed picture of the state of hedges in the county. This, in turn, will lead to planting and management projects which will be discussed with landowners and researched for funding.
- **Become a local coordinator:** Organise training sessions and assessment walks for groups of surveyors and coordinate local surveys. (You can combine this with working as a hedge surveyor.)
- **Join a local planting team** (or form one or, if you are an existing group, join us to become part of a bigger movement). All plantings will be celebrated and marked on the GBDH map – including any not along the Jubilee Way or cross-trails as part of a county-wide network.
- **Set up or contribute to a local tree nursery.** Collect and plant seeds, relocate seedlings from your garden.
- **Draw the attention of your local town or parish council to the GBDH campaign** and suggest how they can help: planting on their land, providing land for a tree nursery, nominating a GBDH link councillor.
- Watch the project develop on the GBDH Map.
